 - iv) The ESC is guiding the direction of UW's Carbon reduction goals
 - (1) Hard task of discussing some cost benefits of strategies

- 3) Email from Matt Wildley, from UW Student co-op
 - a) Want student-run food cart
 - i) All conceptual right now! Might be from UW Farm?
 - ii) Farm Stand? Food Truck? Anything and everywhere in between
 - b) Seeking task force members—anyone from CSF interested?
 - i) If you were on this project, wouldn't be able to vote on it
 - c) Long history with CSF
 - i) Look up more with what you will learn on how to navigate CSF information
- 4) Discuss Committee Scope, Expectations, and "Ground Rules"
 - a) Because the committee is diverse from each year, we should set some ground rules on how to govern ourselves
 - i) From voting in the future, if there is conflict how will we address it
 - ii) Some ideas:
 - (1) We are all equal
 - (2) Accept equal responsibility for our actions
 - (3) If you can't live with the emerging consensus with group, say something so we can discuss
 - (a) In terms of consensus and unanimous votes: a previous group a committee member was a part of had a very well established culture of unanimous votes, so they trying to convince people to all vote the same
 - (b) Thus, disagreement will come up, but don't be afraid of holding a different opinion and to say it
 - (4) Recognize we won't always agree on everything
 - (a) Conflict is okay and is necessary to have the best results
 - (b) Discuss pros vs cons and make a rational decision of everyone
 - (5) Don't pressure others to your idea
 - (6) Speak consisely to get your point across, don't ramble
 - (7) Coming to meetings prepared—read previous week's minutes, read agenda, read proposals with comments, etc.
