This is to offer my thanks for and support of your proposed *Go Team, Go Green (GTGG)*. This would be a great activation and engagement effort that could increase participation in recycling and other sustainability efforts more broadly—not just at UW and CU Boulder, but potentially across the Pac-12.

Not only is it a good idea on its face, I will be bringing this concept forward to the Pac-12 Conference leadership so we can explore how it might harmonize with the Pac-12's emerging sustainability vision. It appears to be very complimentary and would enhance currently existing competitions, such as *Pac-12 Race to Zero Waste* and other Pac-12 activities.
