

Concerns about approval and errors in the process:

Just like last year, our project, the MAPS Pre-Health Conference, does not involve any modifications to campus spaces, permanent installations, or the hiring of full-time staff. It is a temporary event designed to provide valuable information and networking opportunities for students without requiring any structural or long-term changes to the university's infrastructure. Therefore, no major stakeholders are involved in the approval process. The HUB has hosted the event many years now, and there has been no issue in terms of approval for the event (HUB quote attached). This is why the stakeholder section has been left blank.

Liability concerns:

All activities are low risk, and hands-on stations use training models only under supervision by trained facilitators. We follow UW SAO and EH&S event guidelines, confirm room use rules with the HUB, and secure insurance if required.

Other concerns:

Scheduling risk is mitigated by securing backup facilitators and preparing stand-by sessions. We do not collect identifiable data, and all of the collected information is stored in UW Google Drive with restricted access, and we delete personal data that is not needed after reporting.
